- If you see an incident on the field that you believe requires action, inform your team manager as soon as possible. Under YJFL rules, the team manager is the only person permitted to approach the umpires on game day.

Breaches of the League's and our club Code of Conduct can result in suspensions or worse, for players or spectators. If you find that you are unable to watch a game of junior footy without yelling negative comment, then perhaps you should consider staying at home.
