Match Report

Match Report

Believe it or not, this was the first time this group of players actually had an official match at Zwar Park, so while the ground wasn't as bad as we have seen it in past weeks, it was both exciting and great to be part of the day for all involved. This was a game I was really looking forward to as the last time these two clubs faced off, the visitors in Kew showed us plenty and gave us a lot to think about and work on. Their discipline, running and contested efforts were of a standard that we needed to work toward.

Winning the toss the co-captains for the week opted to kick with a relatively strong wind worth at best 3 goals. Knowing it wouldn't be around all day we needed to make an impact on the scoreboard and preferably from the start of the match unlike the last 2 fortnights where we hadn't bothered to trouble the scorer for the entire first half. The target was set and the team didn't disappoint finishing the QTR with 2.3. Then it was Kew's turn to have a go with the wind. The most pleasing thing from my perspective was the challenge I threw to the boys at the QTR time huddle to man up stick close with the contest, make every possession count, hold your marks look for options and so on. They had a go and we saw Kew score their first goal at the 7 min mark of that QTR and while the ball stayed deep in Kew's attacking 50 for the best part of 80%, the result was exactly like that of ours in the first QTR finishing off with 2.3 of their own. So half time it was basically back to the drawing board with both teams locked in at 2.3.15 each. A big second half was needed.

The wind had died down to a slight breeze with no advantage to be had. The aim was to kick at least 2 goals for the QTR as quality opposition such as Kew will make you earn every possession and every scoring attempt. Alex Lukic, was sweeping across everything plucking marks from everywhere which was recognised by Kew Rovers who awarded him their weekly medal. He had strong support from Ethan who just gives everything he has week in week out. Enter some fantastic efforts from Nathan Douglas who had the ball on a string running out of defence and really attacking the footy at every opportunity presented. Pattie Davies played out of his skin. The tackles he laid, were both hard and fair, his contested marks, outstanding. Then his mighty effort to chase down of the bigger boys from Kew who was hot on the heels of Alexander Azzopardi which in itself is an effort to catch him, was like watching an episode of the Road Runner....zoooooom...straight past and slotted in for a nice shepherd to give Alexander an opportunity to dispose of the ball. Truly an amazing passage of play which would have to be right up there with one of the plays of the year. Memorable in fact in that even after the game, Kew Rovers coach James, also highlighted it, so a true testament to Patrick.

In the end however, while we saw a bigger effort which saw a really good contest for 3 QTRS, it was Kew who took the points with some good hard running and strong marking to reward their team with a 3 goal last QTR to run out victors for the day. Proud of our boy's efforts and a lot to like about their continual improvement.

Match Report

If you want to know what an emphatic win is, consider this game. Second played third on the ladder but the general sense was that third placed Gladiators was probably as good if not better than the Bullants. However, the Bullants won the game, played at the Gladiators home ground, by a considerable 70 point. And there's more. This is the highest score kicked by an Under 11s Brown Division team this season. The Bullants continue their run of high scoring games, high winning margins, and goals spread across a long list of players. Yes, this was an emphatic win.

Against a two to three goal wind, the Bullants got on the scoreboard early when Tom M and Maeve pushed the ball forward and Chilly goaled. For the next 10 minutes, following a goal to the Gladiators the teams were locked in a defensive struggle and scores were level. Maivia stood guard against the Gladiators goal. William G had a good quarter. Finn and Ben were strong contributors. The Bullants defence held strong and provided drive for forward attacks. With less than a minute to go this drive paid off when Jackson seized his opportunity in the pocket and goaled.

The Bullants scored 5.4 to nothing in the second, aided by a strong wind, some excellent individual play and a maturing commitment to team work which is defining this team as the season goes on. Julian was everywhere, either scoring or assisting; Matthew M was his usual scoring machine in front of goal. William G and Zac provided good run out of the mid-field. By half time the Bullants had taken complete control of the game and the Gladiators were left wondering what happened.

The Gladiators are not quitters and they came out for the second half ready to wrest control of the game. They scored their second goal and looked like they would be competitive. But the Bullants came here to win. Against the wind, the Bullants again won the quarter.

An impressive note about this quarter was that all three Bullants goals were scored from dead in front, following kicks to the top of the square from the flank – Jackson to Julian; Alex to Matthew M; and Julian to Dylan. Kicking goals from straight in front, courtesy of well delivered passes was a highlight of this game. At least 6 goals were kicked in this fashion, including goals by Jesse (Daniel H pass) and Alex in the last quarter.

The Gladiators kept coming, and for a few minutes the ball stayed in their forward 50 but they could only manage points. Finally, through a very determined piece of play by Maeve, the Bullants took control of the game once more. A tackle in the last by Lawrence was emblematic of the Bullants fire in the belly. The Bullants ran out the game, looking like they could play another quarter if they needed to. This is a good sign as we head towards the Finals. Alex sealed a great win with a booming 40 metre goal on the run. The Gladiators awarded Julian a medal in recognition of his most impressive game.
