Match Report

Round 4, Umpires Appreciation round, had us at home to Park Orchards B with the boys keen on implementing what we rehearsed at training on Wednesday night with the focus being on the "1 percenters" in particular tackling and shepherding. We also worked on another weak area in our marking. We drew up a grid on the back of the team whiteboard and asked the players during the pre-match address, taking the average of 3, how many of these 3 areas they could accomplish per quarter with the trusty IPAD's keeping accurate stats for us. The aim was 15 marks, 7 shepherds and 15 complete tackles where you had to stop your opponent in his tracks.

It is amazing what a visual stimulant can do as opposed to raising one's voice. Respond they did with a match summary of hitting 70% of our marking target, 65% of our shepherding and 80% of our tackling which in my view was a 100% better result to what we displayed the week before. A talented group they are lead out this week by our co-captains in William Beatty and Joshua Malkoun who have both lead from the front by example and were rewarded accordingly. We got out of the blocks early with a goal inside the first minute finishing the first QTR with 2.2 to NIL score. A lot of time was spent inside our attacking forward 50 with not much regard as it became quiet congested as both teams fought hard for clear possession.

The QTR time huddle had the boys focused not on their ground positions for the second QTR but rather the reverse side to see how close they got to their pre-match challenge which was wonderful to see their reactions when we got the chance to discuss it. Out they went in the second QTR which was a replica of the first with a very messy crowded forward half for Preston which saw the majority of our defenders stay in their zones while their opponents went chasing kicks. This suited our structure well with a handful of our boys being reminded of their zones and roles at half time. We added 2 more majors to the scoreboard taking us to 4.2 and while Park Orchards B were yet to score they certainly pressed and pushed up with solid intent.

After a robust discussion at half time, the team responded well with the likes of Joshua Malkoun and Billy Rodda leading out of defence attacking the ball and most importantly backing themselves in their ability which saw both rewarded with solid and impressive passages of play. Add to the mix the "tackling machine" in Zac Vaiano who hit up more tackles in one match then I have seen in the previous 3 of which all were in order and well executed. Any wonder the opposition rewarded Zac with their encouragement award as we did ours! Alexander Azzopardi was up to his old tricks helping himself to 3 majors along the way, with solid mentions to Joseph Mansoor, Terence De Santis, Ethan Lowe, and the "extractor" in little Oscar Stock who put his body on the line and was rewarded a free when given his opportunity to play a role in the midfield. Very pleasing to see. A better team performance all round which saw our intensity drop off in the last QTR as the 3 stats showed us that we still have a lot to work through and work on which we will as each week passes.

Congratulations and thank you to this week's umpires in Michael Amad together with Liam Sutton who always display a fine effort and make what can be a tough gig all round appear seamless. Your time and efforts are appreciated boys and on behalf of the Under 10's we wish you all the best for your future footy careers and wish to simply say thank-you.

Match Report
