Match Report

Our team has been knocking on the door the first 2 rounds, playing solid football, but not quite getting the result. A sign of a good playing group is how they react to this, and to their credit, they turned it around... big time! Due to Warrandyte having a similar coloured jumper and being the older club, Preston had to wear the white jumpers with different numbers on the back. This made it hard for Matt and I to see who was doing what. However, once again, we could look every player in the eye at the end of the game and know that everyone contributed to what can be described as a thumping win.

Although Warrandyte scored the first goal of the match in the opening quarter, that was to be their only opportunity and final score of the match. From that point on, our boys put immense pressure on the contested footy, barely allowing Warrandyte to get the ball. Lachlan followed up last week, with another outstanding display of tackling and grit to stop the opposition. Jacob burst from the packs with great speed to ultimately score 3 goals for the match. Some great work from Nate, Oliver, Sammy putting in great clearing efforts. Luca, our other co-captain for the day, was just a mini brick wall, not allowing anything to get by. The midfield really banded together. Patrick just keeps improving and his clearances were excellent to watch. Jack B was rewarded in the forward line with a toe poke through the goals. His whole game was also outstanding.

3rd quarter- accelerator still to the floor- the boys just kept up the chase and excellent teamwork. Steven was making his presence felt in the ruck and this was his best game so far, continually breaking free with ball and peppering the goals for several behinds. Serge continued his formidable game scoring a runaway goal with a celebratory fist pumping of the air! The Bullants were dominating now. At the 3 quarter break, their enthusiasm was starting to bubble over and we asked them to "keep a lid on it" until the final siren. They answered our request respectfully and forcefully with another powerhouse performance in the final quarter. Match Report
