Match Report

The U10's were "lucky" enough to have an 8:30am start at Surrey Park's ground. Good on all of us for being there @ 7:30am!

The boys seemed fresh and eager to redeem their efforts from last week. There was some hard work done and hard questions asked at training during the week. The coaches were confident the team could turn it around. Seeing as almost all the players had played every position, a strategy was taken to leave the boys in one position or zone for 2 of their 3 quarters, so they could really "own" the position and not be shuffled around the whole ground.

Surrey Park were a very strong opposition, both in size and skills. They were undefeated for a reason and had an incredible percentage of over 2000. Just 24 points have been scored against them all year.

Sure enough, right from the start, the pressure was on our backline and basically continued the whole game. What was impressive from a Bullant perspective was that our boys defence was strong. They did not hang their heads or let the score line bother them. There was constant effort, especially among the backs and centres who were there helping to defend. Damon rose to the occasion and was laying some great tackles and trying to clear the ball, but it was very difficult to get it into our forward line. Nicholas was doing a good job in fullback once he started using the power in his legs to kick out and he also grabbed a confident mark right on the goal line. Isaac had his best game yet and was very strong in defence.

But Surrey Park were relentless. Similar to last week, a big scoring first quarter put us in a difficult position to come back from. But repeating, our Bullants did not give up. Co-captain's Serge and Shaharyar were doing their best running hard to try and create opportunities for us. Toby and Alex were very good in defence. Henry also, was putting a monster effort into the game which was great to see and through these performances, the brakes were put on Surrey Park. At half-time, the game was still not out of reach.

We came out with great fighting spirit in the 3rd quarter with, again, the centres working hard to move the ball forward. Steve was having a good day in ruck where he is very well suited. Surrey Park had some big kickers on their team and the ball quickly shifted to our backline. Xavier G consistently does his best and today was no different in defence. Phoenix was right there with him, again using his big left foot to clear the ball, but it kept on coming. But excellent pressure from Max, Ollie and Jack M distracted the opponent to only score behinds. Going into the fourth quarter it was fantastic to see the boys still running hard and doing their best to win the contested footy.
