Match Report

The boys were up and ready for a hard fought 2nd half after going in at the main break 1.2.8 to Surrey Park's 4.4.28. Plenty of work to be done, and with no less than 5 players missing, the challenge was thrown down to the team.

I am a big believer in ignoring the scoreboard and doing the 1%'s on the ground. If we all play our role, work hard and push hard when it is your turn to do so, then the scoreboard will take care of itself. 43 seconds into the 3rd saw Ethan Lowe take on 3 players, run a good 30 metres before delivering a couple of don't argues and drilling the centre for a major. A rowdy celebration took place and rightly so, for the way Ethan took the team on and had both running and vocal support was a huge positive for the team to feed off. Away we went and in a little under 2 mins Ethan repeated the feat with another major after some great ruck work from Alex Lukic feeding off to Patty Davis being shepherded through the middle and a real solid team effort there on, very pleasing to see. Then it was Pantelis' turn to turn it on with a beautiful snap to cap off some great tackling efforts up the ground to win the contest laid on hard by Joshua Malkoun, Lucas Franin, Alexander Azzopardi and our first gamer and newest member of our great club in Evan Sheedy who took on his early butterflies with a couple of telling defensive marks and laid a couple of great tackles. That is what quality sides do, punish you when you forget your structures. 3QTR time saw Surrey Park 6.5.41 to Preston 4.3.27. Yes, the 2 late goals really hurt the scoreboard.

Throughout the last QTR, our co-captains for the day in Nathan Douglas and Alexander Azzopardi were relentless and really lead by example as they had all day long. Elie Khalife was given a specific role in defence which he took in his stride and delivered a telling QTR. The tackling continued as did the support and run in numbers. We still need to work and persist with our defensive side of the game. The teams tackle count was the highest ever posted on the stats I keep, the intensity around the ball was ever present, the attack on the footy was of a high a standard as I have seen from this group and to finish the day 7.9.51 to 4.4.28 allowed us to take a lot out of the game and plenty to reflect on. Full credit to Surrey Park who pushed and provided contests all day to what was a fair, hard and tough fought contest to see out round 8.
