Match Report

A very excited group of Tackers and parents arrived early for their first game against Fitzroy, fittingly held on "The big stage" at PCO. Equally nervous Coaches & Team Managers got to work mapping out the smaller ground & playing zones, organising excited kids, wrist bands, helpers etc etc.

All too quickly, the game was upon us, Fitzroy were on the field & with a rousing "Go Bullants" we took to the beautiful PCO on a perfect morning.

A quick handshake & exchange of best wishes between the opposing coaches confirmed that Fitzroy were 2 players short & the Bullants mettle was to be tested even before the first bounce. I am proud to say that 8 of our players happily donned the Fitzroy jumper over the course of the day and played in great spirit! Well done to all for setting a great example that was gratefully acknowledged by the Fitzroy coach post match.

A slick Fitzroy outfit and a slightly shell-shocked Bullants resulted in much of the play going the way of Fitzroy in the first quarter but some outstanding individual efforts ensured it wasn't all one-way traffic.

I am very pleased to say that the Bullants learnt quickly over the course of the game and with each subsequent quarter, our leading, decision making and execution improved tremendously! Particularly in the second half, it became more about team effort rather than individuals trying to do it all. The result was some fantastic passages of play that involved multiple players moving the ball quickly from defence to our forward line where opportunities were converted with deadly accuracy (I believe we had 10 scoring shots for 9 goals, 1 behind!). Our defensive pressure also improved dramatically with our players working really hard on picking up a player when Fitzroy had possession and our tackling was ferocious! After the shaky start the Bullants certainly held their own and I am immensely proud of the way they listened & learnt over the course of the game. It is also really rewarding to see such improvements in our skills after only a few short weeks of training. Some fantastic marks were taken and really accurate kicking and handballing was on display.

This was the first real game to test the new U9 rules and I am pleased to say that the kids (and adults) adapted well to the changes. The use of zones helped keep congestion down and ensured all players got involved in the play. It also gives the kids a visual reminder of where they should be on the ground. 15 per side also helped with congestion and increased player involvement.

I must make special mention of our umpire for the game, Max Vaiano. Max was great with the kids, explaining decisions when needed, rewarding marking & tackling efforts and really kept the game flowing. Several parents also commented on the high standard of his umpiring. Thank you very much Max! Your time and work is really appreciated.

Thanks to all of our parents / helpers on the day! Without you, it can't happen!

Match Report

Round 1 took us to Burwood Reserve where we took on Ashburton G for the first clash of the year.
