Match Report:

Clear skies, a stiff cold wind and a still soggy Zwar oval greeted us for our 10am game against St Marys. The tackers modified ground was set up on the far wing to avoid the worst of the mud & ground water. Last week's efforts against the "other" St Marys team saw the kids respond by putting in one of their best training sessions for the year and a commitment from them to increase their efforts, attack on the ball and defensive pressure. Despite several players out with illness, we all hoped that their response at training would carry over to this game.

Quarter 1 saw St Marys come out of the blocks quickly. Using their height & long kicking they caught the undermanned Bullant midfield a little flat footed and placed our backline under immense pressure. The lessons learnt from last week were not lost on our defenders who worked hard to man up but long penetrating kicks from St Marys took their toll and saw them scoring 3 majors for the term all from long range using the wind to advantage. Despite desperate dives from Pat D on the last line of defence, a couple snuck through with only centimetres to spare. The Bullant forwards could only watch from a distance as we struggled to find run out of the middle.

At quarter time, the Bullants were encouraged to keep their heads up & the defensive pressure on. The midfield were clearly struggling against the bigger, fast moving opposition & were asked to lift their attack on the ball...they had to "Want it more!"

Pleasingly, the second quarter saw a response. Samuel Amad (who always works hard!) got increased support from Archie, Ike, Marianne and Perry who all upped their tackle count. In defence, the two Patricks, Jude, Jake, Thomas and Tamer continued to lift after receiving some intense scrutiny during the week. Strong marking and giving their opposing forwards close attention saw St Marys limited to one goal into the wind. Still, forward opportunities were scarce despite strong leads & solid marking from Ayden, Sam and Marcus. The wind didn't seem to be helping us as the couple of shots we had, drifted away for only 1 behind.

Half time & we still weren't totally out of the game but it was going to be tough in the conditions and St Marys still had momentum. A reshuffle to further bolster the midfield, and encouragement to take the game on we sent the Bullants back out to try to turn the tide.

With instructions to play on and take it on, Samuel Amad set about igniting the midfield with his usual flair however even the soggy home ground turned against him when after beating 3 players he had a bounce only to have the ball hit a soggy patch and fail to rebound...at full pace the ball was overrun & collected by the opposition. As always, Sam provides a lot of excitement when he has the ball in hand and is a solid performer every week. Archie, Perry, Ike and Marianne continued to tackle hard and again the backline was sold against a constant barrage of long kicks toward goal. Excellent marking by Tamer, Jude and Pat D saw St Marys limited to 2 goals for the quarter but the game had slipped from reach. Again, the forwards had few opportunities despite their work to get into good positions.

In a last ditch effort to get some forward momentum, silky defender Pat D was thrown into the middle to try and get some run & delivery forward for the final quarter. It was St Marys who had the game on their terms however and finished the job with a 4 goal final term in what their coach described at the end of the game as one of their best this year. Unfortunately they were too good for the undermanned Bullants who felt the loss of their running midfielders but as always there are positives and learning's from the game.

Our defenders should be proud of how they handled themselves & learnt from last week. Against a taller, more polished opponent, their effort, attack on the ball and manning up was excellent.

We will work with the midfield on getting quick kicks away as first option rather than looking to handball or drag the ball back into the packs. It was their ability to drive the ball long out of the centre clearances that gave St Marys an advantage.

Match Report

A cold but clear morning at Pitcher Park in Alphington greeted the visiting Bullants, with Jacob and Seb named co-captains for the day. The first 5 minutes of the game was an arm wrestle on the outer wing. A tricky wind didn't help either team move the ball cleanly, and both teams tackled well which added to the congestion. It was a battle of the midfields, with Liam, Phoenix and Oscar prominent. Both forward lines were starved of any real opportunities for most of the quarter, and Nicholas was important for the Bullants clearing the ball decisively from defence. Neither team could create any meaningful scoring opportunities, and the scoreboard reflected the scrappy, tight contest.

At the ¼ time break, David commended the boys for withstanding Parkside's early pressure and warned against not keeping positional structure. The second quarter saw Parkside come out strongly and use the wind to their advantage. The Bullants found themselves under constant pressure with Parkside missing a couple of opportunities before kicking the first goal of the game from about 25 metres. Remy and Jacob were great in defence, but Parkside had all the momentum, kicking another behind and then snapping another goal before the Bullants could settle in to the quarter. The Bullants persisted, and a free paid to Harvey resulted in a great mark by Jack playing in front. A shot on goal missed but the Bullants were on the board.

The message at half time was to watch our spacing and make sure they can't create a loose man. David also asked the boys to run harder and put some pressure back on Parkside. The third quarter was again played on the outer wing, however the game had opened up and both teams were able to move the ball more quickly. Lachie and Harry stood out with some great tackling and clearing play, and Oscar kept winning possession. Repeated attacks by Parkside saw 2 more points added to their total, and at times the Bullants struggled to clear the ball beyond the half back line.

Three quarter time score – Parkside 2.5.17 – Preston Bullants 0.1.01

David asked the boys to look up and centre the play, and take greater care of the ball when we have possession. Cam fired them up for a big last quarter. The Bullants responded and clearly had the better of the last term. It wasn't long before Liam gained possession at half-forward, and followed a great individual run with a long kick to the pocket. Felix fought hard to win possession, was tackled but managed a handball to Seb. Seb was also under enormous pressure and squeezed a quick short kicked to Joel who snapped truly from the top of the square for a Bullants goal. Another trademark come from behind victory wasn't out of the question, and with plenty of time left in the quarter - the game was up for grabs. But it wasn't our day. The Bullants created a couple of other chances but were denied by a persistent Parkside defence. Harry and Remy dominated the last quarter and helped make sure Parkside remained scoreless for the term. Special mention to Elijah who marked strongly and worked tirelessly in the forward line all day to win the Bullants medal.

Well done to William B on playing his 50th game for the Bullants. A fantastic effort.

On Sunday we played Warrandyte at their home ground who had previously beaten us in round 5 at PCO. A contest between two teams battling for a finals spot. With all kids available this week, the first time since the early rounds, we had to enforce the emergency rule with only 24 kids being allowed to play on the day. A massive thank you to Elwood and Ryan who both made their way to Warrandyte to support with their team mates. No "i" in team for these two boys.

The first quarter started well with our midfield winning the centre clearance and driving the ball into our forward line. Both teams battled hard for the first 5 mins until Nick took a beautiful contested mark 20m out on a slight angle to slot our first and only major for the quarter.
