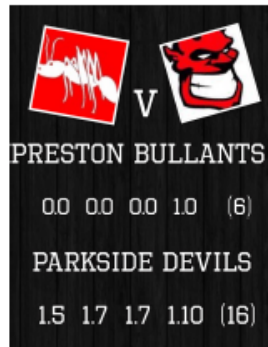

On a chilly, but sunny, May Sunday morning, the Preston Bullants Under 10s played host to the Parkside Devils at Preston City Oval.

The first quarter set the tone for the rest of the match, with the Parkside boys showing poise, dash and skill which immediately set Preston onto the back foot. Parkside peppered the goals, though gained limited reward for their efforts. They eventually scored their first goal with a tremendous snap at the 10 minute mark of the first quarter. The ball remained in Parkside's forward 50 for most of the term. The Bullants' defence did well to limit the damage and they reached the first break trailing by 11 points.

The Preston boys approached the quarter time huddle somewhat dispirited, as they acknowledged that their opposition had outplayed them in all departments in the first quarter. Despite this, David implored his charges to lift their intensity and to keep applying defensive pressure.

The second and third quarters were an arm wrestle. Parkside continued to move the ball forward but found a more committed Preston team in their path. Nathan showed great desperation laying several telling tackles, whilst Lachie did a great job sweeping the ball out of defence. By three quarter time, Preston remained scoreless, but were only 13 points behind. The Bullants had halted Parkside's momentum and had started to believe that a remarkable comeback victory was within their grasp.

The team took the field in the final quarter with renewed enthusiasm but faced a rejuvenated Parkside, who again locked the ball into their forward 50. Preston continued to work hard and refused to be overawed by the challenge at hand. Though Parkside denied them time and space, Preston worked hard to move the ball in-tight and showed tremendous commitment to the contest.

With minutes remaining, Preston seemed to have lost their opportunity to hit the scoreboard. But in an act of courage and determination, Harry collected a ball seemingly destined for the boundary and sprinted down the grandstand wing, before finding a team mate face-out. The ball was then feed out to Phoenix who snapped truly. An appreciative Preston crowd went ballistic when they realised that the two teams were now only separated by 10 points.

In the end, this was to be the final margin, and in truth, the better team won. Having said that, Preston put on an enormous display of committed team football and actually outscored their opposition over the final three quarters.

Post match, the coaches took the unusual step of awarding three medals to players who best exemplified the Bullants team ethos. The medals went to Harry, Harvey and Brody; though their individual accolades were really reflective of a team effort which was characterised by hard work and perseverance.

Match Report

Round 7 at PCO for our third home game in a row.
